TEEN ADVISORY BOARD (TAB)


Teens, do you love your library? This group guides decisions about library events and collections for young people.


Stop by the library to create your own jewelry. We'll provide the supplies and examples, but the time is yours to create what you want. *Register by Friday, February 7*.


