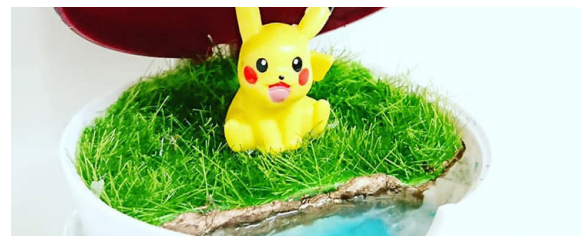


### YA BOOK TO MOVIE CLUB

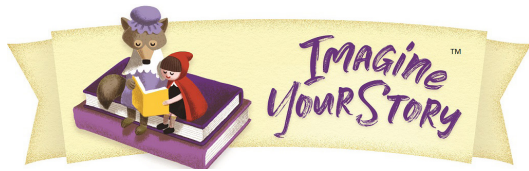
## ALL AGES PROGRAMS

Babies come show off your best dance moves and finest attire at baby prom! Join us for balloons, bubbles, music, and books.



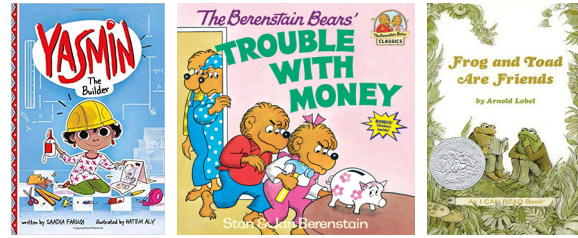
### HANDS ON FUN!

**Monday, March 30 from 10:00-11:00 AM**

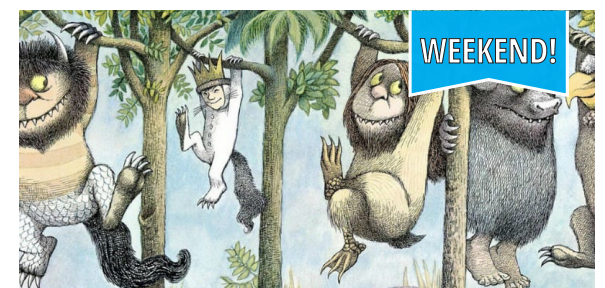
