## **BEAKS**

Birds don't have true teeth. They use their beak for eating, preening, and building nests. The beak is covered in a tough material called keratin. Each bird has a different type of beak for its way of life. Fish-eating birds have a long thin beak for catching fish. Carnion-eating birds have a strong beak for tearing prey apart.
