



What do the FMPL do?

The Friends of Milton Public Library helps carry out the library's mission of opening doors for curious minds, nurturing learning and creativity, creating opportunities, and enriching lives by bringing people and ideas together. They provide an extra level of support not possible through the library's normal operating budget.

An elected board of trustees leads the Friends, and various committees—with the support of library staff—carry out the group's goals and mission.

Money raised through membership dues, fundraisers, and other initiatives allow the library to operate at a higher level by offering additional services, materials, and programs.



The Friends of Milton Public Library has several opportunities to be more involved in the library through several committees:

☐ **Membership** - Maintains a list of due-paying members and contacting members for renewals. Also creates various membership drives and initiatives.

☐ **Scholarship** - Creates criteria for a scholarship that will be offered to graduating seniors. Will also review applications, choose the winning recipient, and present the scholarship.

☐ **Book Sale** - Assists the staff in organizing, sorting, and maintaining the book sale. Will also help in selling special books online.

☐ **Special Events** - Works with the library staff to create and host special FMPL-sponsored events, including fundraisers.
