Distribution will be Friday, January 30 thru Sunday, February 1 during open hours

What to Bring:

New or gently used craft supply donations including, but certainly not limited to:

MARK MAKING: pencils, brushes, pastels, erasers, chalks, charcoals, markers, *unopened* inks or paints

FIBER: yarn, thread, embroidery supplies, knitting needles/crochet hooks, patterns, ribbon, quilting tools, sewing notions, large fabric pieces (1/2 yard or more)

TOOLS: scissors, glue guns, soldering irons, craft knives, hole punches, easels, pottery tools, rulers

SUBSTRATES: canvas, watercolor paper, drawing paper, scratch boards, panels, sketchbooks

EXPENDIBLES: glue, tape, butcher paper, sandpaper, cotton swabs, popsicle sticks, google eyes

CRAFTS: beads, jewelry findings, foam, felt, scrapbooking supplies, stamps, ink pads

BOOKS: art/craft instruction books, patterns, and store-bought crafting kits

If you can buy it at Hobby Lobby or Michael's, chances are it's acceptable.

What NOT to Bring:

Please limit the amount you bring. We do not have space for truckloads, so please bring only your best donations.

Please don't bring anything stinky, moldy, dirty, super heavy, or in need of repair.

We love old vintage stuff, but if it cannot be used immediately and without rehabilitation as crafting material or tool, please don't bring it. This swap is not for antiques or curios.

Please do not bring any hazardous materials, including oil-based solvents, cleaners, house paint, open artists' paints or dry paint tubes. The Milton Public Library has the right to refuse any hazardous materials.

Items not taken in the swap will be donated, recycled, or used in library programs.
