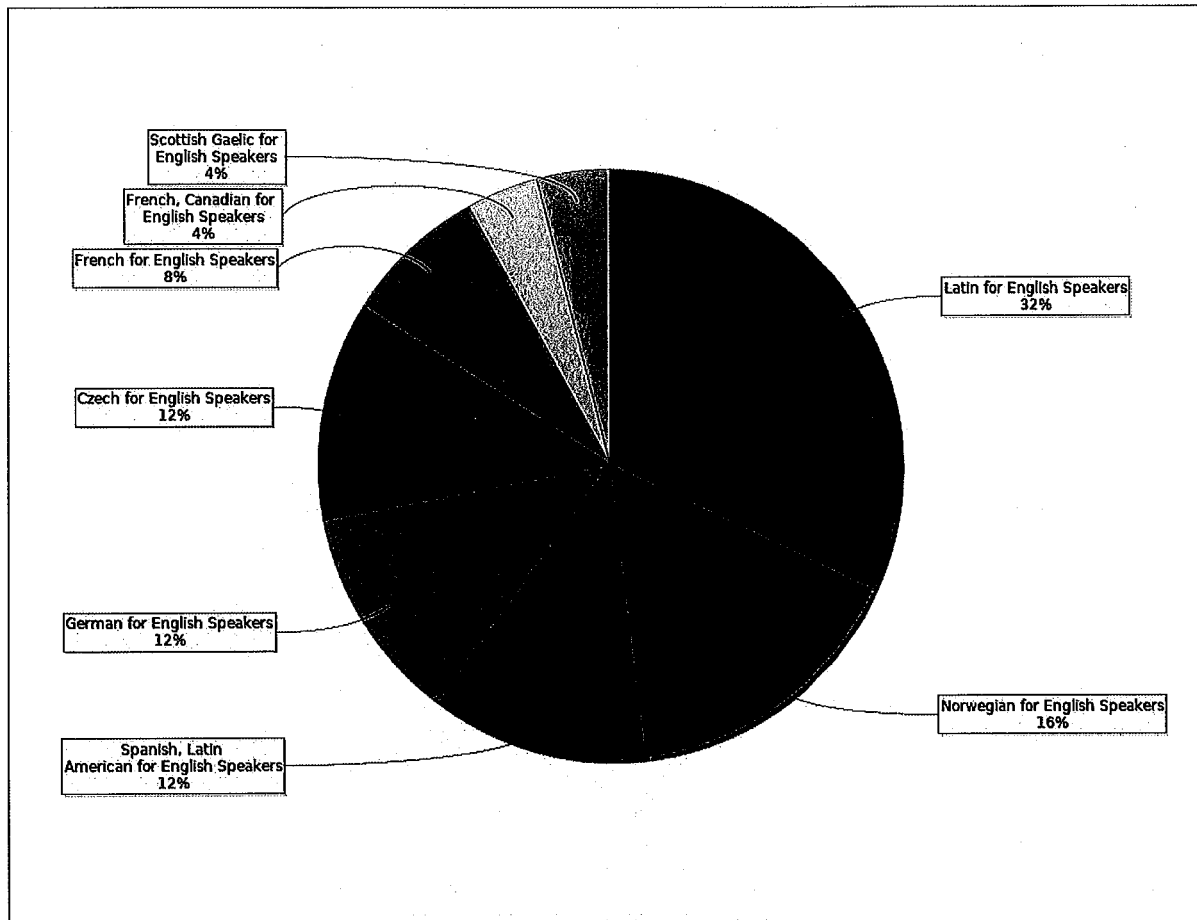

The following message was sent to the directors of eligible public libraries in your system (view eligible libraries as a map). You are encouraged to offer support to your member libraries as they craft brief applications for their scholarship applications for the Research Institute for Public Libraries (RIPL). This is a rare opportunity for your member libraries to apply for a scholarship to this event, and its proximity to Wisconsin this year makes travel expenses more attainable than it had been when offered in Colorado and Georgia.

I would also like to encourage you to explore the facilitator discounted rate of \$1,100 for the full RIPL experience. The facilitator application and rubric are both available online. Facilitating at RIPL is a clearly organized and well-planned role by the institute planners. This is a great way for system staff to attend and participate at RIPL.

DPI will also offer a limited number of state-sponsored scholarship opportunities with support from the Institute of Museum and Library Services (IMLS). I will have more information on the application process and number of opportunities for you and your member libraries soon.

Public library and system staff are welcome to register for the event at full cost starting on February 3, 2020.

I did receive a handful of bounceback emails that I am working to correct and send the message to the correct person (something that a library directory will fix!). Feel free to forward this on to any new directors that are not on the eligible list. You're also encouraged to share this with your system staff who might assist member libraries in applying for this opportunity.

Greetings,

In an effort to connect small and rural libraries with professional development centered on data and evaluation, the Research Institute for Public Libraries (RIPL) is offering you and your staff the opportunity to apply for a scholarship opportunity for the full value of the institute (\$1,300) plus up to \$500 in reimbursable travel costs. With this upcoming institute held from July 12-15, 2020, at the Eaglewood Resort & Spa in Itasca, IL (NW Chicago suburbs), this a great opportunity to engage in an immersive and intensive institute experience in its closest offering to Wisconsin.

Eligibility Criteria

In order to apply for the scholarship for staff working in rural or small library, you must meet these two criteria:

- Work at an eligible public library that is defined as rural or a town by the Institute of Museum and Library Services (IMLS) **OR** serve a population under 25,000 as defined by the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction's service population. You are being contacted because your library is on the list of the 344 eligible Wisconsin libraries. (You can also view this list as a map.)
- Be a first-time RIPL attendee (if you attended the ARSL pre-conferences at the 2016 or 2019 conferences, you are eligible to apply).

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- Be a first-time RIPL attendee (if you attended the ARSL pre-conferences at the 2016 or 2019 conferences, you are eligible to apply).

Application

If you've determined you are eligible and interested in attending, follow these steps from the [Travel Scholarship Opportunity for Staff Working in Small or Rural Public Libraries](#) page:

- Get prepared! The deadline for the application is **Friday, November 22, 2019, at 7:00 p.m.**
- Get support from your supervisor! That would be your board or director, depending on your position at the library. Your supervisor will need to submit a statement of support that agrees that you will participate in the entire institute and will be supported and encouraged to continue to act on what you have learned and share your experience with the rural and small library community. Your supervisor will also need to provide a statement outlining why they support your attendance at RIPL 2020 (recommended length of response is 150-250 words). [Your supervisor can submit their statement of support here.](#)
- Get writing! In addition to some basic application information (who are you and where is your library), you will be asked to answer the following questions: 1) Why are you interested in attending RIPL? and 2) Think about one question you would like to answer about your library, community, or users. In your response, please a) list this question, b) explain why the answer is important to you, and c) describe what skills you hope to learn at RIPL that will help to answer this question. **You'll want to draft these in a word processor first because the online application does *not* allow you to save your responses.** You may also want to ask your system or DPI staff to review your application before you submit. [You can submit your application here.](#)

You are encouraged to review this opportunity and determine if it is appropriate for you or your staff to attend the event. Several Wisconsin public library community members are alumni of RIPL and can be contacted for a firsthand account of what they learned at the institute – reply to me if you want to contact anyone from that list.

More ways to attend

There are three other chances to attend RIPL in 2020: 1) [as a facilitator](#); 2) [by registering for the full event](#) starting on February 3, 2020; or 3) the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction's Division for Libraries and Technology (DLT), with support from IMLS, will offer a limited number of scholarships to attend RIPL. DLT will have more information regarding state-offered scholarship opportunities soon so that potential attendees know if their expenses will be covered by another entity prior to registration opening on February 3, 2020. I look forward to sharing more information soon, and I hope to see many Wisconsin public libraries take advantage of this outstanding opportunity.
